Subject: Announcement

Benjamin ISD is scheduled to begin conducting classes “on campus” again as of Monday, October 12. Buses will run at normal times, and school will be in session as normal. As of this moment, we have had no more positive cases with the Benjamin School Community. All the students and staff members who were under quarantine orders as of Monday, September 28 are eligible to return to school on Monday, October 12. It will be so good to get students back on campus again.

We have cleaned and disinfected the entire campus thoroughly during the time we have been in “remote learning”. And we will continue to clean and disinfect thoroughly each day.

We ask that you continue to watch for symptoms of COVID-19.

Any of the following symptoms indicate a possible COVID-19 infection.

- Temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher when taken by mouth;
- Sore throat
- New uncontrolled cough that causes difficulty breathing;
- Diarrhea, vomiting, or abdominal pain;
- New onset of severe headache, especially with a fever.

If you or any member of the Benjamin School community does begin experiencing any of these symptoms in a way that is not typical, we encourage you to contact your physician. Anyone in the Benjamin School community who is lab-confirmed to have COVID-19 should notify the school at 940-459-2231.
