- 1) I apologize as I had one of the dates listed wrong on the activities next week. I went ahead and listed all the events again, with the mistake corrected in bold print.
- 2) We will have an Awards Assembly for students in grades PK-8 on Tuesday, May 18. This assembly will be held in the gym at 9:30 a.m. Any parents that attend will need to sit in the bleachers and will need to leave immediately following the assembly.
- 3) An Awards Banquet will be held on Tuesday, May 18 at 6:30 p.m. This event will be for H.S. students. A meal will be served at the beginning of the banquet. The H.S. students will eat free. For all others attending, the meal will cost \$8.00. The PTO is supplying the meat for the meal and paying for the H.S. students' meals. The school appreciates the PTO for this very much. The meal is a fund-raiser for the cheerleaders.
- 4) School will dismiss at 1:00 on Wednesday, May 19 and Thursday, May 20. Buses will run at that time on those two afternoons, so please make plans to have your child picked up at the bus stop early on those two days.
